Toddler Program

The Toddler program is for 2-year-old children who are enrolled at Manor. This program is available half day or full day, with Before Care and After Care offered. Children do not need to be potty trained. The Toddler program is led by experienced teachers and is specifically designed for the two-year-old child, as their first school experience. Parents provide diapers and wipes from home.

Primary Program

The Primary program is for children ages 3 - 6. Primary children must be potty trained. This program is available half day or full day, with Before Care and After Care offered.

How to Register

Please submit a Summer Camp Application through our website www.manormontessori.com. Manor families and alumni receive priority. Admission is on a first come, first serve basis.

Payment

A non-refundable \$100 deposit is due with your application and applied to your first week's tuition. There is a 10% discount for siblings.

The entire balance for camp is due by May 16th.

Payments can be made by check made out to The Manor Montessori School to our main office or credit card & ACH bank transfer through your SchoolCues account. No tuition refunds will be made due to absences, health, weather, or withdrawal during a camp session.

Required Health Forms

Children aged 3 ½ and older (**43 months and older**), as well as all currently enrolled students at Manor who submitted health forms for the previous school year, only need to fill out the **Youth Camp Health History Form** included in the online application.

For children between 2 and 3 ½ years old (**24 - 42 months**), additional health forms are required to participate in camp. Please download our Summer Camp Letter, found on our Summer Camp webpage.

If your child has any allergies and needs medication stored at camp the State of Maryland requires an Allergy Action Plan and Medication Administration Form be completed and signed by the child's doctor before the first day of camp. These forms can be found in the Summer Camp Letter, found on our Summer Camp webpage.

If your child has asthma, and needs medication stored at camp the State of Maryland requires an Asthma Action Plan and Medication Administration Authorization Form to be completed and signed by the child's doctor before the first day of camp. These forms can be found in the Summer Camp Letter, found on our Summer Camp webpage.

Additionally, if you would like a member of the Manor Staff to apply insect repellent, or reapply sunscreen to your child, a Topical Basic Care Product Application Authorization Form is required by the State of Maryland.
